- SGA has mentioned this to appropriate Labouré administration

G) Food selection on campus

- SGA President, Kayla: "A lean box representative left a contact number if people had any suggestions for the LeanBox"
- LeanBox uses local vendors that provide healthy and fresh options; some items are in high demand and cannot be restocked until the vendor produces more

- SGA would like to monitor when LeanBox is restocked and discuss food items that are more favorable to the community

 - Suggestions made to include study cubicles and more tables or desks
